\$100,000.00 Golf Shoot Out
Rules and Regulations

- Payment for balls must be in the form of a cash or check. Make checks payable to the Venango Museum. No credit cards are accepted.
- All shots must be taken with a museum representative present as a witness.
- Women will shoot from the same spot as men.
- Shots for the qualifying round will be taken from the pad.
- There is a 10-minute shooting time limit per participant, to assist with avoiding a backlog of people waiting to participate in the event. All Preliminary and Semi-final shots are “closest to the pin”. Shots will be measured once all balls purchased are shot, and will be measured from the pin (the side closest to the ball) to the edge of the ball closest to the pin.
- The Preliminary rounds will use a circle 20 feet in circumference. Shots will be measured inside the circle once all balls purchased are shot and will be measured from the pin (the side closest to the ball) to the edge of the ball closest to the pin. Balls landing inside the line will be measured; those outside the line are deemed out of contention.
- If a participant is shooting and
 - A ball hits a ball he already shot knocking it closer or farther away the ball is measured from where it is once all balls have been shot.
 - If the participant wishes to stop shooting because he has shot a ball which he feels is a good shot and does not want to risk knocking it farther away with another ball he may do so, however no money will be refunded for any balls not shot.
- Participants who qualify for the finals will be notified by telephone or if present in person by 5:00 p.m. on June 12th, or A.S.A.P. The event committee, museum and /or its associates will not be held responsible for any participant that cannot be reached by the stated time. If an answering machine is reached, a message will be left for the participant. Please speak to the range coordinator before leaving.
- It is the responsibility of all qualifying participants to verify whether they have reached the finals by checking with staff at the shoot-out at the end of the round, but before the finals.
- Finals - shot is a hole-in-one
- Final shot will be made from a tee with both tee and ball provided by the Museum.
- Prizes will be paid out by check to adults and gift certificates to students.
- In accordance with the hole-in-one insurance company regulations:
 - No pro golfers are permitted to shoot for the hole-in-one.
 - No practice shots permitted for the final shoot out.
 - The insurance company may conduct a reasonable investigation of the facts surrounding a hole-in-one, and reserves the right to require the Venango Museum to produce the winner and any witnesses for polygraph examination as a condition for payment
- In the event of a disagreement, Event Coordinator may confer with other committee members but is the final judge.
- Time for the event will be kept by the official clock placed at the sales tent
- Participants that have their name on the board at any time must sign that they understand the rules and regulations and will receive a complete copy of the rules and regulations.
- Yardage being shot will be posted in the area of where the participant will be shooting.

Semi-finals:

To be held on: June 12 - 10:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m.
Cost: \$1.00 per ball or 12 balls for \$10.00
Shooting Distance: 150 yards

Participants are permitted to purchase and shoot as many balls as they would like. There will be no refunds on balls purchased during the qualifying round for any reason, including time running out on the event. The top five participants closest to the pin will receive \$100 and move to the finals. No balls will be sold after 4:00. Shots made after the alarm goes off at 4:30 p.m. will not be eligible.

Finals: “Hole in One”

To be held on: June 12 at 5:00 p.m.
Cost: **There is no cost for participants in the finals**
Shooting Distance: 165 yards

Each of the participants will have one ball to shoot at the hole and try to make a hole-in-one to win \$100,000.00. If no hole-in-one the participant closest to the hole will receive \$500 consolation prize, if there is a tie, the \$500 will be divided among the winning participants.
